Exodus

- Read chapter 1

Exodus

- Key things from chapter 1:
 - Israelites were fruitful, increased greatly
 - New king of Egypt feared Israelites
 - Afflicted them with heavy burdens
 - Made them work as slaves

Exodus

- Question to ponder on:
 - Think about what some of the effects / fruit would be from living in this kind of environment for hundreds of years?

Exodus

- *During those many days the king of Egypt died, and the people of Israel groaned because of their slavery and cried out for help. Their cry for rescue from slavery came up to God. And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. God saw the people of Israel – and God knew. Ex.2:23*

Exodus – chapter 2

- What do we learn about Moses upbringing?
 - Born into the priesthood family (Levites)
 - Raised by his mother for 3 months (Acts 7:20)
 - Brought to Pharaoh's daughter when he was older

Exodus

- Read Exodus 2:11-23

Exodus

- What are some of the character traits in Moses?
 - Heart for his people
 - Rescuer
 - Deliverer
 - Protector

Exodus

- Read chapters 3 and 4

Exodus

- Moses' excuses:
 - Who am I?
 - What shall I say your NAME is?
 - They will not listen to me
 - I am not eloquent of speech
 - Send someone else

Exodus

- Observation: What do we notice of God's response to Moses' excuses?

Exodus

- Question: What excuses do we give to God when He asks us to do something?

Exodus

- Question: What was God's purpose for Moses being in the wilderness for 40 years?

Exodus

- Showdown of power between God and gods of Egypt
- *Moses and Aaron went and said to Pharaoh, 'Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, 'Let my people go, that they may hold a feast to me in the wilderness. But Pharaoh said 'WHO IS THE LORD that I should obey his voice and let Israel go?*
Ex.5:1-2

Exodus

- Read Exodus 13:17-22
- Read Exodus 14: 26-31
- Read Exodus 15:22-25
- Ready Exodus 16:9-12

Exodus

- *God's method of provision was designed to teach them obedience and daily dependence upon God*

Exodus

- *Now therefore if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation Ex.19:5*

Exodus

- *And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell in their midst. Exactly as I show you concerning the pattern of the tabernacle and all of its furniture, so you shall make it Ex.25:8*
